My research interests include: new methods in teaching geography at schools, GIS and Remote Sensing as tools for teaching geography, the future of school geography in Europe, Web mapping.

I have participated in 28 national and international research projects, have published 66 articles in national and international journals and conferences, seven (7) project reports and have written five (5) books on school geography and map reading, three (3) text books for university students, three (3) chapters in books, seven (7) books as editor, one e-book and 2 CD-ROMs for Greek primary school teachers.

In 2012 I established the Hellenic digital earth Centre of Excellence, <http://www.digital-earth.edu.gr>, which is an educational and research Centre, supported by the Aristotle University of Thessaloniki, Greece, promoting the use of geomedial in geography teaching in all levels of education (especially primary and secondary). It has a network of 230 members and 33 associated primary schools.

In 2021 I established the Greek European Space Education Resource Office (ESERO Greece) which promotes STEM Education through Space applications in all education levels in Greece.
