Ioannis Grivas is Associate Professor of Anatomy, Histology and Embryology at the Department of Veterinary Medicine of the Aristotle University of Thessaloniki since 2022. He holds a degree in Veterinary Medicine (DVM, 1998) and a PhD (Ph.D., 2006) from the same Department, with a scholarship from the State Scholarships Foundation.

His research focuses on neuroscience, specifically on brain vasculature and neurogenesis in the adult brain, with an emphasis on differences along the septotemporal axis of the hippocampal formation, as well as on the comparative anatomy of various species. He has published 26 papers in international scientific journals, has participated in numerous international and national conferences and has written chapters in scientific books and university notes.

He has participated in competitive research programs, including those of the Hellenic Society for the Study of Neuroscience, the Research Committee of the Aristotle University of Thessaloniki and the international ICRAD program. He is a reviewer in international scientific journals and a member of scientific societies, such as the Federation of European Neuroscience Societies (FENS) and the Hellenic Society of Neuroscience.

His teaching work includes teaching, at undergraduate level, Animal Anatomy, Histology and Embryology in the Departments of Veterinary Medicine and Agriculture of the Aristotle University of Thessaloniki, as well as in postgraduate programs of Medicine and Dentistry of the Aristotle University of Thessaloniki and the International Neuroscience Program of the National University of Athens. He has supervised doctoral and postgraduate theses, degree theses of Departments of the Aristotle University of Thessaloniki and undergraduate theses of Veterinary Medicine students.

He has served as a member of administrative committees of the Department of Veterinary Medicine and the Aristotle University of Thessaloniki, is a Veterinarian in Charge and a member of Protocol Evaluation Committees in animal model facilities. He actively participates in public information and awareness-raising actions for Neuroscience (Brain Awareness Week) and in training seminars for veterinarians.
